

The June meeting of the Johnstown Town Board was called to order at 6:00 p.m. by Chairman Logterman. The meeting was posted in 4 locations in the town. Present: Dennis Logterman, Robert Mawhinney, Carmen Corwith, Patsy Weber and Mary Mawhinney. Absent: none.

The agenda was reviewed and approved on a Corwith/Mawhinney motion

Citizen's input- Maurice Peterson asked if anyone knew where there were some utility poles not in use this is what he uses to make the sign posts. Ray Yessa said there are kids running up and down Emerald Grove Rd on 4 wheelers.

The clerk's report was read and approved on a Mawhinney/Corwith motion. The treasurer's report was reviewed and approved on a Corwith/Mawhinney motion. The treasurer requested permission to take some money out of the State Pool and place it in an interest bearing CD in order to get more interest, the state pool is paying 0.43% and she can get a CD for around 2%, a Corwith/Mawhinney to approve the request, carried. The treasurer will use her judgment in selecting the bank and report back to the board. A Mawhinney/Corwith motion to transfer the funds and pay the bills, carried.

Mike Lange from Veolia was present to discuss the contract options the town has for recycling. The suggestion is to go to every other week for recyclables and they would furnish another bin to all residents in some cases 2 new bins (most of the bins in the town are 10 years old) if the town is willing to do this for the year 2010 the charge would be \$14.82 per month per household. The board asked about going to a larger bin type with wheels and what the cost would be, they will have to get back to us with that. Each household is allowed 8 tires per year to dispose of.

A Mawhinney/Corwith motion to approve the liquor license applications and cigarette license applications from Johnstown Food Center and Dorr's Prairie Woods Golf Course, also 9 bartenders license applications (list attached), carried.

Road Work- Enbridge has not been available to work with. General town maintenance Frank Brothers recommends an overlay on part of 6 Corners Rd, E of Hall Rd where the shade trees are. Dennis purchased 25 delineators for the towns roads. Logterman has phoned Christianson about the mowing for the town, they will be starting soon. Richard Stanley asked if Scharine Rd could be raised at the intersection on Co A and Scharine. More pot hole filling needs to be done on 6 Corners Rd.

Zoning officer report- permits issued to John Cordio for a shed, Dudley Kimbel for a deck, remodel house to Overbeck. There was a weed complaint on the Morse property on Co A and Lima Center Rd.

Community Center- Weber will fix the toilets and the hole in the wall.

A Mawhinney/Corwith motion to table the Smart Growth resolution until the town attorney has a chance to review the plan, carried.

The next meeting will be July 20, 09 at 6:00 p.m. Open Book will be Monday June 24 from 2-4 and board of review will be from 5-7.

A Mawhinney/Corwith motion to adjourn, carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:10 p.m.
