

The October 18, 2010 Board of Review was called to order by 1st Supervisor Corwith at 6:00 p.m. A Mawhinney/Corwith motion to set November 10, 2010 from 4:00 p.m. to adjournment (at least 2 hours), carried. A Mawhinney/Corwith motion to adjourn carried.

The October meeting of the Johnstown Town Board was called to order at 6:00p.m. A Mawhinney/Corwith motion to approve the agenda carried. The meeting was posted in 4 locations in the town and on the town's website. Present: Dennis Logterman, Carmen Corwith, Robert Mawhinney, Patsy Weber, and Mary Mawhinney. Absent: none.

Citizens' input- Amy Laudenbach was present to remind people to vote and that she will represent the 45th district responsibly. Kerry Schlitler introduced himself as running for the office of Clerk of Courts. Dr Suzanne Zentner from the Whitewater School District was present to explain the referenda that the school district has on November ballot. Paul Benjamin and Steve Schafnagel were present from Rock Co Planning to discuss the changes being made to the farmland preservation law and offering the counties help in reviewing the towns ordinance. Logterman suggested having the planning and zoning committee and the town board meet with the county for a review workshop after the first of the year.

The clerks report was read and approved with the following correction: Logterman did not sign off on the letter from Enbridge for fixing the road crossing fixed by Enbridge. The treasurer's report was read and approved on a Corwith/Mawhinney motion. A discussion on the retainer fee for the town attorney was held the board agreed to retain Dave Moore for the 2011 year. A Mawhinney/Corwith motion to transfer funds and pay the bills carried, there were no unusual bills.

The salvage license applications were presented the fees have been paid a Mawhinney/Corwith motion to approve licenses for Head's Auto Salvage and 3-D Auto Salvage, carried.

Zoning officer report he issued 2 permits and 1 application for a conditional use permit.

Community Center- everything is working ok. Corwith went over the quote for steel for the front portico it is \$1012.75, complete. The board will need to remove the old shingles and put up the steel and look into eaves, an exact measurement will need to be gotten before the steel is ordered.

Roadwork- the latest offer from Enbridge is \$240,000.00 the board declined this offer. Mowing on Co Line Road was done by the Town of Richmond will need to contact Christianson prior to next year's mowing.

The 2011 budget hearing will need to be postponed until the close of Board of Review. A Mawhinney/Corwith motion to reschedule the budget hearing to November 22, 2010 at 6:00 p.m. carried. The next town board meeting will be November 16 at 6:00 p.m.

A Logterman/Corwith motion to adjourn carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:15 p.m.
